PLEASE NOTE: Harvest times are approximate (as they are weather dependent).

All our peaches are **YELLOW** flesh varieties, except for the "WHITE LADY" peach.

Yellow flesh peaches are great for all uses: Canning, baking, and eating fresh.

* The white flesh "WHITE LADY" peach is excellent for eating fresh and in salads.



LATE JULY

PEACH	DESIREE	Semi-freestone, vibrant crimson blush, firm, juicy.
PEACH	PF 5D "BIG"	"Paul Friday" variety, large size, sweet, freestone.

EARLY AUGUST

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	SUMMER SERENADE	Semi-clingstone, firm, traditional peach flavor.
PEACH	RISINGSTAR	Semi-freestone, mostly red skin, firm.
PEACH	PF 8 "Ball"	"Paul Friday" variety, very round shape, lots of natural sugar content.
NECTARINE	BRIGANTINE	Semi-freestone nectarine, nicely acidic flavor.
PEACH	STARFIRE	Freestone, juicy, nectar sweet.
PEACH	REDHAVEN	Freestone, creamy sweet yellow flesh.
PEACH	BLAZINGSTAR	Freestone, firm, yellow, sweet.
PEACH	* WHITE LADY	Freestone, WHITE flesh, best for fresh eating, low acid/high sugar.

MID AUGUST

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	PF "Lucky 13"	"Paul Friday" variety, firm, flavorful, sweet.
PLUM	SANTA ROSA	Firm, gold flesh, good fresh or for canning.
PEACH	GLO HAVEN	Juicy, sweet, fuzz-free skin great for canning.
PEACH	CORALSTAR	Freestone, coral/yellow color flesh, firm, sweet.
PLUM	SATSUMA	Large, dark red flesh, juicy, developed in Japan.

LATE AUGUST

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	ALL STAR	Firm, freestone, juicy, sweet, nearly fuzzless.
PEACH	CANADIAN HARMONY	Round, firm, sweet, freestone, great for salads as it's slow to brown.

EARLY SEPTEMBER

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	GLORIA	Low acid, high sugar, firm, freestone, excellent dessert peach.
PEACH	PF 24C	"Paul Friday" variety, freestone, bold flavor, juicy.

MID-LATE SEPTEMBER

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	SELENA	Large, excellent flavor, freestone.
PEAR	COLD SNAP	Crisp, juicy, flavorful.
PEACH	VICTORIA	Firm, yellow flesh, great flavor, maintains fruit quality in cold storage.

Wondering who PAUL FRIDAY is? He's a Michigan peach grower who developed the "PF" or "Paul Friday" varieties. He's in the Guinness Book of World Records for growing the record-breaking heaviest peach, weighing in at a whopping TWO POUNDS. That's about five times heavier than an average peach! He's known for developing better Michigan peach varieties for over 30 years, improving their flavor, size, and hardness.
