

## PEACH - PEAR - NECTARINE SEASON varieties & harvest windows

**PLEASE NOTE: Harvest times are approximate (weather dependent).**

Most of the peaches we grow are **YELLOW** flesh varieties, except for our white fleshed "White Lady," "Sugar Giant" and "Donut" varieties.

YELLOW flesh peaches are great for all uses: Canning, baking, and eating fresh.

WHITE flesh varieties are lower in acidity & excellent for eating fresh or in salads.



### LATE JULY

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	DESIREE	Semi-freestone, vibrant crimson blush, firm, juicy, honey notes, hint of tartness.
PEACH	Paul Friday 5 "Flamin' Fury"	"Paul Friday" variety, large size, rich, balanced sweet & tart, juicy, freestone.

### EARLY AUGUST

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	BLAZINGSTAR	Freestone, firm, creamy sweet/slightly tart. Great for eating fresh/grilling.
PEACH	Paul Friday "8 Ball"	"Paul Friday" variety, round, freestone, lots of natural sugar content, tangy.
PEACH	REDHAVEN	Freestone, classic sweet tart balanced taste, aromatic creamy yellow flesh.
PEACH	RISINGSTAR	Semi-freestone, red blush, firm, rich honeyed notes, sweet/tart, slow to brown.
PEACH	STARFIRE	Freestone, juicy, classic taste, delightfully nectar sweet/tangy, slow to brown.
PEACH	SUMMER SERENADE	Semi-clingstone, firm & juicy, with a wonderful traditional peach flavor.
PEACH	* <b>WHITE LADY (white flesh)</b>	Freestone, WHITE flesh, best for fresh eating, low acid/high sugar.
<b>NECTARINE</b>	BRIGANTINE	Semi-freestone nectarine, nicely balanced sweet & spicy tart flavor.

### MID AUGUST

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	CORALSTAR	Freestone, coral/yellow color flesh, firm, balanced very sweet yet mildly tangy.
PEACH	* <b>DONUT PEACH (white flesh)</b>	Sweet, nearly fuzzless, freestone, unique flat shape, great for fresh eating.
PEACH	GLO HAVEN	Juicy, classic rich & sweet flavor, freestone fuzz-free skin great for canning.
PEACH	Paul Friday "Lucky 13"	"Paul Friday" variety, freestone, firm, flavorful, sweet & very juicy.

### LATE AUGUST

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	ALL STAR	Firm, freestone, juicy, sweet with a pleasant tang, nearly fuzzless.
PEACH	CANADIAN HARMONY	Firm, sweet with balanced acidity, freestone, slow to brown (great for salads).
<b>PEAR</b>	BLAKE'S PRIDE	'Bartlett' type pear; aromatic & juicy, with smooth/buttery texture.

### EARLY SEPTEMBER

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	GLORIA	Low acid, high sugar, firm, freestone, vibrant & aromatic, great dessert peach.
PEACH	Paul Friday 24C "Flamin' Fury"	"Paul Friday" variety, freestone, bold flavor, juicy, sweet with tart/tangy finish.
PEACH	* <b>SUGAR GIANT (white flesh)</b>	Large, succulent, white flesh, freestone, mild honey-like sweetness, low acid.
<b>PEAR</b>	BELL	Sweet/juicy, intense flavor/aromatic. Developed by breeder Richard Bell.

### MID-LATE SEPTEMBER

Type	Variety Name	Attributes
PEACH	SELENA	Large aromatic fruit, complex yet balanced sweet/tart flavor, freestone.
PEACH	VICTORIA	Firm, freestone, classic sweet & juicy flavor, maintains quality in cold storage.
<b>PEAR</b>	COLD SNAP	"Bartlett" type pear; crisp, juicy, flavorful, with hints of lemon & floral notes.
<b>PEAR</b>	HARROW CRISP	"Bartlett" type pear; cream white flesh with a sweet yet refreshing mild flavor.

Who is PAUL FRIDAY? He's a Michigan peach grower who developed the "PF" or "Paul Friday" varieties. He's in the Guinness Book of World Records for growing the record-breaking heaviest peach, weighing in at a whopping TWO POUNDS. That's about five times heavier than an average peach!
